8 2. Supply statistical and financial data to the Department of Human9 Services, Developmental Disabilities Services.

3. Establish and maintain a sound financial management system in accordancewith guidelines as set forth by the Department of Human Services.

4. Establish and maintain community support programs designed to provide coordinated care and treatment to ensure ongoing involvement and individualized services for persons with disabilities. Every community support program shall provide services for persons with disabilities who reside within the respective area of the program.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2010
<u>2012</u> through June 30, 2011 <u>2013</u>.

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20 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 21 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 22 DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES - TIMBER SALES PROCEEDS - CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND 23 EQUIPMENT. The Division of Developmental Disabilities Services is authorized 24 to use the administrative operating accounts for capital improvements to 25 physical plants and for the purchase of capital equipment. The funds shall be 26 held by the Department of Human Services, Division of Developmental 27 Disabilities Services from the proceeds of the sale of timber that may be 28 harvested from land owned by the Division of Developmental Disabilities 29 Services. All funds deposited and all expenses shall be tracked separately. 30 The harvesting of timber is specifically authorized to provide funds to 31 finance capital improvements to the physical plants and for the purchase of 32 major capital equipment.

33 The Division of Developmental Disabilities Services shall report all 34 income derived from timber management to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the 35 State and the Arkansas Legislative Council. Any contracts initiated for the 36 harvesting of timber shall be submitted to the Review Subcommittee of the 1 Arkansas Legislative Council for prior review. All expenditures of funds

2 derived from the sale of timber will be expended in accordance with relevant 3 state purchasing laws.

4 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2010
5 <u>2012</u> through June 30, 2011 <u>2013</u>.

SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. HUMAN
DEVELOPMENT CENTERS AND COMMUNITY PROVIDERS.

(A) The Developmental Disabilities Services Board or the Department of
Human Services shall not close any of the state administered Human
Development Centers which are located at Conway, Arkadelphia, Jonesboro,
Booneville, and Warren.

(B) The Department of Human Services shall continue to accept clients for whom it has determined that therapy and residential services are needed at state administered Human Development Centers and Community Programs licensed by DDS shall continue to accept clients for whom it has been determined in accordance with federal law that are in need of services in the community.

(C) Except for use as federal matching funds, no funds for community based services licensed by DDS shall be transferred from Grants to Community Providers line item of the Developmental Disabilities Services - Grants-in-Aid appropriation unless the transfer(s) directly benefit(s) community based services for persons with developmental disabilities or from the appropriation for the Human Development Centers unless the transfer(s) directly benefit(s) the Human Development Centers.

27 (D) Nor shall any general revenue funding as of July 1, 2012 from 28 the Grants to Community Providers line item of the Developmental Disabilities 29 Services - Grants-in-Aid appropriation for persons with developmental 30 disabilities or from any other general revenues as of July 1, 2011 2012, 31 applied as federal matching funds for community based services licensed by DDS on July 1, 2011 2012 be reduced below the approved funding level on July 32 33 1, 2011 2012; nor shall the general revenues applied as federal matching 34 funds for the Human Development Centers be reduced below the approved funding 35 level on July 1, 2011 2012.

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1 SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. AUTISM 2 TREATMENT AND COORDINATION. The Department of Human Services - Division of 3 4 Developmental Disabilities Services shall promulgate rules and regulations 5 regarding the licensure and oversight of Applied Behavior Analysts as 6 described in Arkansas Code § 23-99-418. The rules and regulations shall 7 include a requirement for a licensure application fee equal to that charged 8 to applicants to be licensed as a psychologist as described in Arkansas Code 9 § 17-97-309. Proceeds from this fee are declared as cash funds.

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11 SECTION 18. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 12 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 13 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 14 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 15 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 16 17 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 18 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 19 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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SECTION 19. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 21 22 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 23 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 24 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 25 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 26 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 27 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 28 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 29

30 <u>SECTION 20. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the</u> 31 <u>General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits</u> 32 <u>the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the</u> 33 <u>effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2012 is essential to the operation of</u> 34 <u>the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in</u> 35 <u>the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the</u> 36 <u>effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2012 could work irreparable harm</u>

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1	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
2	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
3	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
4	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2012.
