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SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COMMUNITY CORRECTION PROGRAM LINE ITEM USES. The appropriations authorized under the line item established herein for "Community Correction Program" are to be used by the Department of Community Correction for establishment and operation of, to include construction, renovation, and contracting for establishment and operation of, residential and non-residential community correction programs such as, but not limited to, community correction centers, drug, alcohol, and mental health treatments, intensive supervision, restitution, and others as established and approved by the Board of Corrections and as may be provided by law.

34 SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 35 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 36

AUTHORITY FOR UTILITY AND FUEL RATE INCREASE. In the event of a ten percent

- 1 (10%) increase in utility and fuel rates, the Department of Community
- 2 Correction is authorized to transfer from any line item in Section 3 State
- 3 Operations to Operating Expense Item (04)(A) in Section 3 State Operations
- 4 for support of the increase after receiving approval of the Chief Fiscal
- 5 Officer of the State. Prior to the utilization of the transfer authority a
- 6 report shall be made to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
- 7 Committee including justification for the transfer and the amount of
- 8 transfer.

- 9 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of

13	SECTION 21. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
14	authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency

32	SECTION 23. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
33	General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
34	the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
35	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2013 is essential to the operation of

the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in

1	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
2	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2013 could work irreparable harm
3	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
4	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
5	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
6	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2013.
