31	the Arkansas State Highway Employees' Retirement System divided by the sum of
32	all years of service credit with the reciprocal systems enumerated in § 24-2-

35	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 24-5-125(c)(4), concerning Arkansas State
36	Highway employees' eligibility to receive an increase in benefits, is amended

6	under this section for all members retiring after June 30, 2009 the effective
7	date of this act.
