17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
18

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-37-208(b), concerning the offense of
20 criminal impersonation in the second degree, is amended to read as follows:

21 (b)(1) A person commits criminal impersonation in the second degree if
22 the person does an act in his or her pretended or assumed capacity or
23 character with the purpose to injure, ~~or~~ defraud, harass, or intimidate
24 another person and the actor:

25 (A) Assumes a false identity;

26 (B) Pretends to be a representative of a person or
27 organization;

28 (C) Pretends to be an officer or employee of the
29 government other than a law enforcement officer described in subsection (a)
30 of this section; ~~or~~

31 (D) Pretends that he or she is a law enforcement officer
32 when the person is not a law enforcement officer; or

33 ~~(D)~~ (E) Pretends to have a handicap or disability.

34 (2) Criminal impersonation in the second degree is a Class A
35 misdemeanor.
