27	rules for the sale of public property by the Department of Finance and

30	authorized to promulgate reasonable rules and regulations, not inconsistent
31	with law, for compliance with the provisions of this section, the Arkansas
32	Procurement Law, § 19-11-201 et seq., and the General Accounting and
33	Budgetary Procedures Law, § 19-4-101 et seq., and the sale of surplus
34	commodities to not-for-profit organizations under § 22-1-101.
