8	(b) The county board may, by agreement with the county clerk, transmit
9	the certified results to the county clerk who shall transmit the certified
10	results by precinct to the Secretary of State as described in subsection (a)
11	of this section.
12	(b)(c) The Secretary of State may require a county board of election
13	commissioners to submit additional election information as determined by the
14	Secretary of State.
