24	(1) Removes a transmittal device from a <i>dog used in hunting</i> or a
25	raptor used in falconry without permission of the owner; and
26	(2) With the purpose to prevent or hinder the owner from
27	locating the dog used in hunting or raptor used in falconry.
28	(b) Removal of an animal's transmittal device is a Class C
29	misdemeanor.
30	(c)(1) Upon a finding of guilt, the court shall order that the
31	<u>defendant pay as restitution the actual value of any dog used in hunting or</u>
32	raptor used in falconry lost or killed as a result of the removal of the
33	animal's transmittal device.
34	(2) The court also may order restitution to the owner for any
35	lost breeding revenues.
