28	authority for the purpose to injure or defraud the person, the person:		
29	(A) Pretends to be a law enforcement officer by wearing or		
30	displaying, without authority, any uniform or badge by which a law		
31	enforcement officer is lawfully distinguished; or		
32	(B) Uses a motor vehicle or motorcycle designed, equipped,		
33	or marked so as to resemble a motor vehicle or motorcycle belonging to a		
34	federal, state, or local law enforcement agency.		
35	(2) Criminal impersonation in the first degree is a Class D		
36	felony.		

1	(b)(l) A person commits criminal impersonation in the second degree is		
2	the person does an act in his or her pretended or assumed capacity or		
3	character with the purpose to injure, defraud, harass, or intimidate another		
4	person and the actor:		
5	(A) Assumes a false identity;		
6	(B) Pretends to be a representative of a person or
