(b) Emergency contact records shall otherwise not be modified and
shall otherwise be deleted only when the driver's license or identification
<u>record no longer exists in Arkansas.</u>
(c) All requests to add, modify or delete a record in the emergency
system is confidential and shall be governed by § 12-12-211.
