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SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 2 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EMERGENCY 3 4 GRANTS & EXTRA HELP POOL. An Institution of higher education that suffers an 5 emergency/disaster event resulting in all or a significant portion of campus 6 operations being interrupted, may request disaster assistance through the 7 Arkansas Department of Higher Education. Upon the declaration of an 8 emergency by the Governor, the institution may request, subject to the 9 recommendation of the Director of the Department of Higher Education and 10 approval of the Governor, a grant from the Disaster Relief Fund to assist in 11 returning that campus to operation and/or to a sister campus providing services to the students from the affected campus. Certified law enforcement 12 13 officers employed by an institution of higher education may be granted 14 jurisdiction at the sister institution, upon agreement of both institutions. 15 The Department of Higher Education is authorized a pool of 500 extra help 16 positions for use in such emergency situations. These positions may be 17 assigned to the campus suffering the disaster event or to a sister campus 18 providing services to the students from the affected campus. The Governor 19 may waive the 1,500 hour limit of ACA 6-63-314 on these assigned extra help 20 pool positions.

Upon 27 determination by the president or chancellor of an institution of higher 28 education that a reallocation of resources for purposes of reorganization or 29 consolidation of administrative functions within the institution is necessary 30 for efficient and effective operations of the institution, the president or 31 chancellor, with approval of the institution's board of trustees, may have 32 the authority to transfer positions, appropriations and related funds between 33 campuses, divisions, branches, and other budgetary units of the institution, 34 after receiving prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget 35 Committee. The transfers of positions, programs, or activities shall be used 36 for those purposes for which the appropriations were approved by the General

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1 Assembly. The transfers, consolidations, or reorganizations which involve 2 academic programs shall be reviewed by the Department of Higher Education 3 prior to submission to the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee. 4 Provided, however, that the institution shall be limited to submitting no 5 more than two (2) individual transaction transfer requests during any fiscal 6 year and shall be further limited to no more than five percent (5%) of the 7 total General Revenue and Special Revenue appropriation, funding, positions 8 specific to each institution, and no Tobacco Settlement funds or 9 appropriations may be reallocated pursuant to this section. 10 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of 11 appropriation and general revenue funding for institutions of higher 12 education each fiscal year is the prerogative of the General Assembly. The Department of Higher Education will 24 distribute funds from the Outcome-Centered Funding Awards Appropriation based 25 upon the outcome-centered funding policy of the Arkansas Higher Education 26 Coordinating Board.

27 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 28 <u>2013</u> <u>2014</u> through June 30, <u>2014</u> <u>2015</u>.

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30 SECTION 43. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 31 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 32 ADMINISTRATIVE FEES. The Department of Higher Education is authorized to 33 recover non-refundable administrative fees related to the institutional 34 certification and exemption process for out-of-state, non-public, and for-35 profit colleges and universities. These fees include a notification fee, an 36 application processing fee, and travel expenses for the certification review

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SECTION 44. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 5 6 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 7 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 8 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 9 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 10 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 11 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 12 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 13 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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15 SECTION 45. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 16 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 17 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 18 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 19 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 20 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 21 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 22 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 23

24 SECTION 46. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 25 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits 26 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2014 is essential to the operation of 27 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 28 29 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2014 could work irreparable harm 30 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 31 32 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 33 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health 34 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2014. 35
