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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established
23 for the Mid-South Community College for the 2014-2015 fiscal year, the
24 following maximum number of regular employees.

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12 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for
 13 the Mid-South Community College for the 2014-2015 fiscal year, the following
 14 maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra
 15 Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: two hundred
 16 (200) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to
 17 exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or
 18 its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

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20 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby
 21 appropriated, to the Mid-South Community College, to be payable from the Mid-
 22 South Community College Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of
 23 the Mid-South Community College for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015, the

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27 SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION - ADTEC/UNIVERSITY CENTER PARTNERS. There is
 28 hereby appropriated, to the Mid-South Community College, to be payable from
 29 the Mid-South Community College Fund, for personal services, operating
 30 expenses, equipment and grants to Arkansas Delta Training and Education
 31 Consortium (ADTEC) Partners and University Center Partners for the fiscal
 32 year ending June 30, 2015, the sum of.....\$2,046,000.

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34 SECTION 6. ALLOCATIONS - ADTEC/UNIVERSITY CENTER PARTNERS. There is
 35 hereby allocated to the Arkansas Delta Training and Education Consortium
 36 (ADTEC) Partners and University Center Partners the following amounts of the

1 funds appropriated in Section 5 of this Act, there to be used as provided by
 2 in this Act, for the period ending June 30, 2015, the following:

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 16 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 17 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

18 ADTEC/UNIVERSITY CENTER PARTNERS - TRAINING CONSORTIUM ADVICE. The Mid-South
 19 Community College upon counsel with and advice from the Arkansas Delta
 20 Training and Education Consortium (ADTEC) shall disburse funds from the
 21 ADTEC/UNIVERSITY CENTER PARTNERS appropriation authorized in this Act to
 22 selected University Center Partners and also the participating ADTEC
 23 Partners.

24 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2013~~
 25 2014 through June 30, ~~2014~~ 2015.

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 27 SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
 28 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
 29 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
 30 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
 31 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 32 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures
 33 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this
 34 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
 35 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
 36 with in disbursement of said funds.

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SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2014 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2014 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2014.
