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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established
23 for the Arkansas Northeastern College for the 2014-2015 fiscal year, the
24 following maximum number of regular employees.

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29 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for

30 the Arkansas Northeastern College for the 2014-2015 fiscal year, the

31 following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as

32 "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: five

33 hundred twenty-one (521) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at

34 rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and

35 Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate

36 classification.

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SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Northeastern College, to be payable from the Arkansas Northeastern College Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas Northeastern College for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015, the following:

SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - CASH FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Northeastern College, to be payable from cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Arkansas Northeastern College, for personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas Northeastern College for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015, the following:

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9 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
10 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
11 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
12 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
13 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
14 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures
15 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this
16 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
17 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
18 with in disbursement of said funds.

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20 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
21 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
22 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
23 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
24 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
25 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
26 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
27 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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29 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
30 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
31 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
32 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2014 is essential to the operation of
33 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
34 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
35 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2014 could work irreparable harm
36 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental

1 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
2 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
3 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2014.
