7 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 8 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. YOUTH 9 SERVICES - COMMUNITY-BASED RESIDENTIAL PROGRAMS - RESTRICTIONS. The 10 Department of Human Services shall not contract or pay for community-based 11 residential programs within any municipality to house unrelated persons who 12 have been adjudicated delinquent of an act that would constitute a Class A 13 felony or higher or of a sexual offense or convicted of a Class A felony or 14 higher or sexual offense until the following conditions have been met:

15 1. Residents within one thousand (1,000) feet of the proposed location of 16 the facility shall be notified by mail;

17 2. A public hearing shall be conducted in the community of the proposed 18 location of the facility by the contract provider at least ten (10) days in 19 advance of the contract's effective date. Notice of the hearing shall be made 20 by mail to each of the residents within 1,000 feet of the proposed location 21 of the facility. The notification requirement shall not apply to already 22 existing facilities at already existing locations.

Provided further, upon establishment of such facilities within a particular municipality, the contract provider and the Department shall establish and implement a system to receive and respond to complaints and questions from residents of such municipality. In the event the Department and the provider fail to provide satisfactory communication as provided in this section to the residents, such facility may be declared a public nuisance by the municipality.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2013
<u>2014</u> through June 30, 2014 <u>2015</u>.

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33 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 34 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 35 OF FUNDS FOR THE JUVENILE OMBUDSMAN PROGRAM. The Department of Human 36 Services shall provide funding in an amount not to exceed \$240,000 for the

fiscal year ending June 30, 2014 2015 for the Juvenile Ombudsman Program described in ACA 16-87-216. Upon request by the Executive Director of the Arkansas Public Defender Commission, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer an amount not to exceed \$240,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014 2015 from an account designated by the Director of the Department of Human Services to the State Central Services Fund as a direct revenue to fund the Juvenile Ombudsman Program.

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SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 9 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 10 11 OF FUNDS FOR LOCAL JUVENILE DETENTION FACILITIES. The Chief Fiscal Officer 12 of the State shall transfer funds in an amount of \$400,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014 2015 from the Department of Human Services - Youth 13 14 Services Fund Account to the Juvenile Detention Facilities Operating Fund to 15 fund the appropriation to the Department of Finance and Administration -16 Disbursing Officer for grants for operating expenses of local juvenile 17 detention facilities.

24 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 25 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. YOUTH 26 SERVICES - TIMBER SALES PROCEEDS - CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND EQUIPMENT. The 27 Division of Youth Services is authorized to use the administrative operating 28 account for capital improvements to the physical plant and for the purchase 29 of capital equipment by the Mansfield Youth Services Facility operated by the 30 Department of Human Services, Division of Youth Services. The funds shall be 31 held by the Department of Human Services, Division of Youth Services from the 32 proceeds of the sale of timber that may be harvested from land owned by the 33 Division of Youth Services. All funds deposited and all expenses shall be 34 tracked separately. The harvesting of timber is specifically authorized to 35 provide funds to finance capital improvements to the physical plant and for 36 the purchase of major capital equipment by the Mansfield Facility from which

1 the timber is sold.

The Division of Youth Services shall report all income derived from the sale of timber to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and the Arkansas Legislative Council. Any contracts initiated for the harvesting and sale of timber shall be submitted to the Review Subcommittee of the Arkansas Legislative Council for prior review. All expenditures of funds derived from the sale of timber will be expended in accordance with relevant state purchasing laws.

12 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. REGULAR 13 14 SALARIES - CONTINGENT EDUCATIONAL SERVICES POSITIONS. If it has been 15 determined by the Director of the Department of Human Services that the 16 Division of Youth Services cannot continue a contract with a private provider 17 for educational services and deems it necessary to utilize Division staff to 18 provide the required educational services, the Division is authorized, to 19 seek the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the Governor and 20 the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, to utilize the 21 contingent educational services positions contained in this Act and to make 22 the appropriate transfers from the Residential Services Appropriation line 23 item contained in this Act to Regular Salaries, Personal Services Matching, 24 and various Maintenance and General Operations classifications.

25 There is hereby established for the Division of Youth Services -26 Contingent Educational Services Positions for the 2013-2014 2014-2015 fiscal 27 year, the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall 28 be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation 29 Act (Arkansas Code 21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws 30 amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific 31 maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the 32 provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. 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18 SECTION 14. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 19 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 20 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 21 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 22 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 23 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 24 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 25 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 26 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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28 SECTION 15. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 29 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 30 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 31 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 32 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 33 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 34 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 35 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 36

1	SECTION 16. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
2	General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
3	the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
4	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2014 is essential to the operation of
5	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
6	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
7	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2014 could work irreparable harm
8	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
9	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
10	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
11	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2014.
