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21 SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 22 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 23 CONTRACTUAL SERVICES LIMITED. No more than 85% of the funds appropriated for 24 Professional Fees and Services may be expended each fiscal year for 25 contractual services of an attorney to represent the Commission when 26 reviewing cases of judicial misconduct. Provided further, none of these 27 funds shall be spent for contractual services of an attorney until it has 28 been determined by the Attorney General these services cannot be provided by 29 his office.

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The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2013 31 2014 through June 30, 2014 2015.

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SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
