18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-87-312(e), concerning offenses that
21 prohibit nursing licensure, is amended to read as follows:

22 (e) Except as provided in subdivision (1)(1) of this section, ~~ne~~ a
23 person shall not be eligible to receive or hold a license issued by the board
24 if that person has pleaded guilty or nolo contendere to or has been found
25 guilty of any of the following offenses by ~~any~~ a court in the State of
26 Arkansas or of any similar offense by a court in another state or of any
27 similar offense by a federal court:

- 28 (1) Capital murder as prohibited in § 5-10-101;

11 prohibited in § 5-27-605.
