8	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 26, Chapter 52, Subchapter 4, is
9	amended to add an additional section to read as follows:
10	26-52-451. Sales of certain aircraft.
11	(a) The gross receipts or gross proceeds derived from the sale of an
12	aircraft within the state are exempt from the gross receipts tax levied under
13	this chapter and the compensating use tax levied by the Arkansas Compensating
14	Tax Act of 1949, § 26-53-101 et seq. if the aircraft is sold by a person that
15	is the resident of another state to a purchaser that:
16	(1) Is a resident of another state; and
17	(2) Will base the aircraft outside of the State of Arkansas.
18	(b) The fact that a purchaser takes possession of an aircraft in this
19	state does not prevent the application of the exemption provided in this
20	section if the purchaser takes possession of the aircraft for the sole
21	purpose of:
22	(1) Removing the aircraft from this state under its own power;
23	<u>or</u>
24	(2) Locating the aircraft at a maintenance facility in this
25	state for the time period necessary to complete maintenance or modifications
26	to the aircraft if the aircraft is removed from this state upon completion of
27	the maintenance or modifications.

29	SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
30	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the current statutes governing
31	the taxes applicable to certain aircraft sales hinder the ability of certain
32	service providers to earn a living; that amending the law will provide
33	additional opportunities for Arkansas citizens to obtain work; and that this
34	act is immediately necessary because it is important to Arkansas's economy to
35	encourage and enable the state's citizens to obtain these types of service
36	contracts whenever possible. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist,

1	and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public
2	peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:
3	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;
4	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
5	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
6	bill; or
7	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
8	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
