2	Coordinating Board, in collaboration with all public university and community						
3	college presidents and chancellors or their designees, shall develop an						
4	action plan to address the prevention of unplanned pregnancies among older						
5	teens who are unmarried.						
6	(b) The action plan shall:						
7	(1) Incorporate unplanned pregnancy prevention information for						
8	students through advising and student orientation;						
9	(2) Integrate information that is recognized as medically						
10	accurate by the American Congress of Obstetricians and Gynecologists about						
11	the prevention of unplanned pregnancy into academic courses if and when						
12	appropriate, including without limitation abstinence education;						
13	(3) Identify opportunities to raise awareness of and provide
