9 IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE INSTITUTIONS OF  
10 HIGHER EDUCATION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

13 AN ACT FOR THE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER  
14 EDUCATION REAPPROPRIATION.  
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18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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20 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - HENDERSON STATE UNIVERSITY - GENERAL  
21 IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Henderson State  
22 University, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor  
23 fund or fund accounts, for the Henderson State University the following:

24 (A) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided  
25 in Item (A) Section 3 of Act 201 of 2015, for Phase I renovation to various  
26 campus buildings, in a sum not to exceed.....\$3,000,000.

27 (B) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided  
28 in Item (B) Section 3 of Act 201 of 2015, for construction of a School of  
29 Business building and renovation of Mooney Hall, in a sum not to  
30 exceed.....\$2,000,000.

31 (C) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided  
32 in Item (C) Section 3 of Act 201 of 2015, for upgrade and replacement of  
33 campus network infrastructure, in a sum not to exceed.....\$1,800,000.

34 (D) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided  
35 in Item (D) Section 3 of Act 201 of 2015, for furnishings and equipment for  
36 the Hot Springs Education Center, in a sum not to exceed.....\$200,000.



1 (E) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided  
2 in Item (E) Section 3 of Act 201 of 2015, for deferred maintenance, in a sum  
3 not to exceed.....\$1,690,000.

4 (F) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided  
5 in Item (F) Section 3 of Act 201 of 2015, for the purchase, replacement, and  
6 renewal of equipment and library holdings, in a sum not to exceed  
7 .....\$596,197.

8 (G) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided

10 maintenance, critical maintenance, equipment, security enhancements,  
11 technology upgrades/equipment and library resources, in a sum not to  
12 exceed.....\$62,500.

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14 SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - HENDERSON STATE UNIVERSITY - TRUST - CADDO  
15 CENTER RENOVATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Henderson State  
16 University, to be payable from the Arkansas Natural and Cultural Resources  
17 Grant and Trust Fund, for the Henderson State University the following:

18 (A) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided  
19 in Item (01) Section 29 of Act 718 of 2015, for acquisition, management,  
20 stewardship or preservation of state owned lands, historic sites, buildings,  
21 structures or objects, in a sum not to exceed.....\$747,000.

31 Arkansas University, to be payable from the Arkansas Natural and Cultural  
32 Resources Grant and Trust Fund, for the Southern Arkansas University the

25 SECTION 27. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
26 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
27 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
28 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
29 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
30 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
31 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
32 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.  
33

34 SECTION 28. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the  
35 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits  
36 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the

1 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2016 is essential to the operation of  
2 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
3 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
4 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2016 could work irreparable harm  
5 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
6 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
7 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
8 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2016.
