29	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-13-804(b), concerning the powers and
30	duties of the Department of Health regarding the trauma system, is amended to

32	(b)(1) The department shall allocate funds deposited into the Public
33	Health Fund to administer this subchapter.
34	(2) The allocation of available funds shall be developed and

Arkansas Code § 20-13-807 is amended to read as follows: 16 20-13-807. Trauma Advisory Council. 17 There is established an advisory council, to be known as the (a) 18 "Trauma Advisory Council", for the purpose of making recommendations, 19 advising, and providing assistance to the Department of Health concerning the 20 development and operation of a statewide trauma system. 21 (b) The council shall consist of twenty (20) twelve (12) voting 22 members who have a demonstrated interest in trauma systems to be appointed by 23 the Governor subject to confirmation by the Senate as follows: 24 (1) One (1) member appointed by the Governor after consulting 25 the Arkansas Chapter of the American College of Emergency Physicians; 26 (2) One (1) member appointed by the Governor after consulting 27 the Arkansas Academy of Family Physicians; 28 (3) (2) One (1) member appointed by the Governor after consulting 29 the Arkansas Chapter of the American College of Surgeons; 30 (4) (3) One (1) member appointed by the Governor after consulting 31 the Arkansas Medical Society; 32 (5)(4) Four (4) Three (3) members appointed by the Governor 33 after consulting the Arkansas Hospital Association; 34 (6) (5) One (1) member appointed by the Governor after consulting 35 the Emergency Medical Services Advisory Council; 36 (7) One (1) member appointed by the Governor after consulting

26	Arkansas Medical, Dental, and Pharmaceutical Association and the Arkansas
27	Emergency Nurses Association; and
28	(2) Two (2) members to be appointed by and to serve at the
29	pleasure of the Speaker of the House of Representatives after consulting the

31	(d) The following <u>Director of the Department of Health or his or her</u>

35	(2) The Director of the Department of Arkansas State Police or

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2	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 20-13-808(e)(1), concerning a quorum of the
3	Trauma Advisory Council, is amended to read as follows:
4	(e)(1) Thirteen (13) <u>A majority</u> of the voting members of the council
5	shall constitute a quorum for the purpose of transacting business.
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7	SECTION 4. DO NOT CODIFY. TEMPORARY LANGUAGE. Education requirements
8	within the rules of the Department of Health regarding trauma systems.
9	Until March 1, 2019, the Department of Health may either waive or
10	substitute educational requirements within the rules regarding trauma systems
11	to ensure that hospitals retain their trauma level designation.
