

4	SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds	
5	authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agenc	y
6	and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and	Ĺ
7	the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and	
8	Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary	,
9	Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal	
10	control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated b	y
11	the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall b	e
12	strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

14	SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General	
15	Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations	•
16	contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for	
17	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive	
18	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget	
19	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters,	or
20	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislati	.ve
21	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

23	SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the Gener	<u>:a1</u>
24	Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of	<u>:</u>
25	the Department of Education are, due to unforeseen circumstances,	
26	insufficient for the Department of Education to continue to provide essenti	<u>.al</u>
27	governmental services; that the provisions of this act will provide the	
28	necessary monies for the Department of Education to continue such services;	=
29	and that a delay in the effective date of this Act could work irreparable	
30	harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental	<u>-</u>
31	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act	
32	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health	
33	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its	<u> </u>
34	passage and approval.	
35	If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall	
36	become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the	

1	Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the
2	veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house
3	overrides the veto.
