11 SECTION 22. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 12 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PARK 13 BUDGET ALLOCATION. Prior to July 1 of each fiscal year, the Legislative 14 Council or the Joint Budget Committee shall review the Parks and Tourism 15 Department's plan for the upcoming year of amounts to be disbursed for each 16 park or other entity from the funds appropriated for State Operations of this 17 Act.
