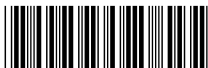

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
24

25 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-65-402(a)(3), concerning the surrender of
26 a driver's license or permit to an arresting officer, is amended to read as
27 follows:

28 (3)(A) Any notice from the office required under this subchapter
29 that is not personally delivered shall be sent by ~~certified mail~~ first class
30 mail and is deemed to have been delivered on the date when postmarked and
31 shall be sent to the last known address on file with the office.

32 (B) Refusal of the addressee to accept delivery or
33 attempted delivery of the notice at the address obtained by the arresting law
34 enforcement officer or on file with the office does not constitute nonreceipt
35 of notice.

36 (C) For any notice that is personally delivered, the



1 person shall be asked to sign a receipt acknowledging that he or she received
2 the required notice.
