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23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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25 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 26, Chapter 51, Subchapter 4, is
26 amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

27 26-51-460. Opportunity zones.

28 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, 26 U.S.C. §
29 1400Z-2, as in effect on January 1, 2018, regarding opportunity zones, is
30 adopted for the purpose of computing Arkansas income tax liability.

31 (b) As used in this section and for purposes of the adoption of 26
32 U.S.C. § 1400Z-2, "opportunity zone" means a population census tract located
33 in Arkansas that is designated as a qualified opportunity zone under 26
34 U.S.C. § 1400Z, as of January 1, 2019.
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36 SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective for tax years



1 beginning on or after January 1, 2018.
