1	(a)(l)(A) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State may create paying
2	accounts on his or her books and on the books of the Treasurer of State and
3	the Auditor of State for the payment of personal services and operating
4	expenses by the Department of the Inspector General.
5	(B) Upon prior approval of the Arkansas Legislative Council, or
6	if meeting in Legislative Session the Joint Budget Committee, the Chief
7	Fiscal Officer of the State shall direct the transfer of funds and
8	appropriations to the Shared Services Paying Account appropriation section of
9	this act and the transfer of positions to the Regular Salaries — Shared
10	Services appropriation section of this act on the books of the Treasurer of
11	State, the Auditor of State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State.
12	(2) The transfer authority provided in subdivision (a)(1) of
13	this section for efficiencies and to eliminate duplication of services are
14	limited only to those services that are provided for multiple divisions of $\underline{a}$
15	department, including without limitation to administration, human resources,
16	procurement, communications, fleet operations, and information services.
17	(3) The transfer authority provided to the department in

- (c)(1) It is the intent of the Ninety-Second General Assembly that the authority under this section to transfer positions is intended for use for the time period prior to Fiscal Year 2022 to allow cabinet-level departments to establish a centralized Regular Salaries Shared Services section, with the recommendation that the position transfer authority granted under this section be discontinued after that time.
- 8 (2) The Bureau of Legislative Research shall bring the
  9 recommendation in subdivision (c)(1) of this section to the attention of the
  10 chairs conducting the 2021 Regular Session pre-session budget hearings, the
  11 chairs of the Special Language Subcommittee, and the members of the Special
  12 Language Subcommittee during pre-session budget hearings.
- 13 <u>(d) Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount</u> 14 <u>of appropriation and general revenue funding for a cabinet-level department</u>

SECTION 20. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and

1	Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
2	Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
3	control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
4	the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
5	strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.
6	
7	SECTION 21. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
8	Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
9	contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
10	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
11	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
12	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
13	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
14	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
15	
16	SECTION 22. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
17	General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
18	the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
19	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2020 is essential to the operation of
20	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
21	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
22	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2020 could work irreparable harm
23	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
24	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
25	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
26	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2020.
