26	reimbursement.
27	(a) A person eligible to receive per diem compensation or mileage
28	reimbursement, or both, under this chapter may donate the per diem
29	compensation or mileage reimbursement, or both, that he or she receives to an
30	eligible nonprofit entity.
31	(b)(1)(A) The Administrative Office of the Courts shall compile a list
32	of eligible nonprofit entities to which a person receiving per diem
33	compensation or mileage reimbursement, or both, under this chapter may make
34	his or her donation under this section.
35	(B)(i) In compiling the list of eligible nonprofit
36	entities described under subdivision (b)(l)(A) of this section, the office



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1	shall consult with the Supreme Court and the Arkansas Judicial Council, Inc.,
2	to determine the eligible nonprofit entities under this section.
3	(ii) The office is encouraged to seek input through
