20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
21

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-25-307 is amended to read as follows:
23 17-25-307. Expiration.

24 (a) All certificates of license or registration to engage in
25 performing the services of a contractor as defined under § 17-25-101 in the
26 State of Arkansas shall expire at 12:00 midnight on the day before the
27 anniversary date of issuance unless otherwise designated by the Contractors
28 Licensing Board, and all certificates of license or registration shall become
29 invalid on that day unless renewed.

30 (b) A registration may be renewed for a period of one (1) year, two
31 (2) years, or three (3) years with the fee of one hundred dollars (\$100) per
32 year.

34 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 17-25-512 is amended to read as follows:
35 17-25-512. Expiration of license – Fees.

36 (a)(1) All licenses issued by the Contractors Licensing Board shall



1 expire one (1) year after the date of issuance unless otherwise provided by
2 the Residential Contractors Committee.

3 (2) The committee may charge reasonable examination fees and
4 delinquency fees and may charge a fee not to exceed one hundred dollars
5 (\$100) for new licenses or renewal of a license.

6 (3) All fees and other moneys collected by the committee shall
7 be disposed of as provided by § 17-25-205 and shall be used by the board to
8 implement this subchapter.

9 (b) The committee may provide by rule for renewal of licenses for a
10 period of one (1) year, two (2) years, or three (3) years with the fee not to
11 exceed one hundred dollars (\$100) per year.
