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1 SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION - REAPPROPRIATION - CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICERS 2 FUND. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Senate, to be payable from the Constitutional Officers Fund, for the balance remaining on June 30, 3 4 2021 in the appropriations Section 3 of Act 1 of 2020, Sections 4 and 5 of 5 Act 98 of 2020 and SB1 as introduced in the 2021 Regular Session there to be 6 used for any purpose to defray the necessary expenses of the Arkansas Senate 7 of the Ninety-Third General Assembly, in a sum in the aggregate not to 8 exceed.....\$3,500,000. 9

SECTION 6. APPROPRIATION - REAPPROPRIATION - STATE CENTRAL SERVICES 10 11 FUND. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Senate, to be payable 12 from the State Central Services Fund, and payable from the balance remaining 13 on June 30, 2021 in the appropriations, Section 3, 6, 7 and 8 of Act 98 of 14 2020 there to used for any purpose to defray the necessary expenses of the 15 Arkansas Senate of the Ninety-Third General Assembly, in a sum in the 16 aggregate not to exceed..... \$3,500,000. 17

SECTION 7. APPROPRIATION - COMPUTERIZATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Senate, to be payable from the State Central Services Fund, for expenses necessary in continuing the computerization of the legislative process in the Arkansas Senate, the sum of......\$700,000.

23 SECTION 8. APPROPRIATION - RENOVATIONS AND IMPROVEMENTS. There is 24 hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Senate, to be payable from the State 25 Central Services Fund, for construction, improvements, renovations and 26 equipping of the Arkansas Senate facilities and other purposes of the 27 Arkansas Senate, the sum of......\$700,000. 28

29 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 30 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 31 TRANSFERS. If the Senate Efficiency Committee and the Secretary of the 32 Senate, subject to the approval of the Arkansas Senate, should determine that 33 any item or portion thereof appropriated herein for a specific purpose is not 34 needed for such purpose, the Secretary of the Senate may certify such fact to 35 the State Auditor and the State Auditor shall cause a transfer to be made 36 from one item to another.

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2 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 3 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SALARIES. 4 In order that exceptionally well-qualified personnel may be recruited and 5 retained, the Senate may exceed the maximum salary levels by no more than 6 twenty percent (20%) for no more than one-third (1/3) of the positions 7 authorized in their operation appropriation act, and may exceed the maximum 8 salary levels for the purpose of merit adjustments for all positions. 9

10 SECTION 11. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 11 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 12 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 13 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 14 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 15 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 16 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 17 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 18 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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20 SECTION 12. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 21 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 22 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 23 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 24 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 25 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 26 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 27 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 28

SECTION 13. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 29 30 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 31 32 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2021 is essential to the operation of 33 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 34 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2021 could work irreparable harm 35 36 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental

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1	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
2	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
3	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2021.
