23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

25 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
26 Department of Transformation and Shared Services - Division of Information
27 Systems for the 2022-2023 fiscal year, the following maximum number of
28 regular employees.

6 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Department
7 of Transformation and Shared Services - Division of Information Systems for
8 the 2022-2023 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or
9 temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds
10 appropriated herein for such purposes: eighteen (18) temporary or part-time
11 employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the
12 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act
13 for the appropriate classification.

14

15 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,
16 to the Department of Transformation and Shared Services, to be payable from
17 the Division of Information Systems Revolving Fund, for personal services and
18 operating expenses of the Department of Transformation and Shared Services -
19 Division of Information Systems for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023, the
20 following:

 2 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - EQUIPMENT ACQUISITIONS AND INFORMATION
 3 TECHNOLOGY IMPROVEMENTS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of
 4 Transformation and Shared Services, to be payable from the Information
 5 Technology Reserve Fund, for major equipment acquisitions and information
 6 technology improvements, as set out in Arkansas Code §25-4-122 and §25-4-123
 7 by the Department of Transformation and Shared Services - Division of
 8 Information Systems for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023, the following:

 15 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 16 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
 17 COMPLIANCE WITH STATE AND FEDERAL REGULATIONS.

18 1. In order to effect compliance with the requirements of state and federal
 19 statutory and regulatory provisions, the Director shall adjust billing rates
 20 or issue billing adjustments to be federally compliant, notwithstanding the
 21 provisions of ACA §25-4-105 and §25-4-119 or funds sufficient to effect
 22 compliance shall be provided the Division from General Revenues, Special
 23 Revenues or such other fund sources as may become available. These actions
 24 shall be subject to the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and
 25 approval by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee.

26 2. The Director shall have authority to transfer funds between the
 27 Information Technology Reserve Fund established by ACA §25-4-123 and the
 28 Division of Information Systems Revolving Fund established by ACA §25-4-121
 29 for cash management purposes.

30 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
 31 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
 32 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
 33 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and
 34 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
 35 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly
 36 has determined that the Division of Information Systems may operate more

1 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Division of Information
2 Systems authorizing broad powers under this section. Therefore, it is both
3 necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by
4 requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
5 as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative
6 Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section.
7 If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget
8 Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction,
9 this entire section is void.

10 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2021~~
11 2022 through June 30, ~~2022~~ 2023.

12
13 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
14 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. GIFTS,
15 GRANTS AND DONATIONS. (i) The Director may accept on behalf of the Division
16 of Information Systems, from any source, funds including but not limited to
17 special or general revenue, gifts, grants, cash, bequeaths, devices,
18 donations, real or personal property and equipment. (ii) The Division shall
19 quarterly file with the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
20 Committee a report summarizing all funds, gifts, grants, cash, bequeaths,
21 devices, donations, real or personal property and equipment received. (iii)
22 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2021~~ 2022
23 through June 30, ~~2022~~ 2023.

24
25 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
26 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
27 PROVISION - LINE ITEMS - DIVISION OF INFORMATION SYSTEMS - OPERATIONS. After
28 receiving approval from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and prior
29 review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, the
30 Secretary of the Department of Transformation and Shared Services is
31 authorized to transfer appropriation between the line items authorized herein
32 for the Division of Information Systems - Operations to best utilize
33 resources to respond to the needs of the Division's customers.

34 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2021~~
35 2022 through June 30, ~~2022~~ 2023.

1 SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
 2 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
 3 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
 4 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
 5 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 6 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
 7 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
 8 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
 9 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

10
 11 SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
 12 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
 13 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
 14 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
 15 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
 16 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
 17 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
 18 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

19
 20 SECTION 10. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective on and after July 1,
 21 2022.
