33	the safety of incarcerated citizens, and the proper functions of the
34	correctional system; that the Governor's oversight and executive authority is
35	critical to ensuring the public health and safety; and that this act is
36	immediately necessary because a uniform reporting structure for all

2	public's health and safety. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and

6	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
7	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
8	<u>bill; or</u>
9	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
