27	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
28	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that some public school districts
29	in the State of Arkansas are currently facing administrative consolidation;
30	that there is a designated timeline for administrative consolidations
31	conducted by the State Board of Education; and that this act is immediately
32	necessary in order to statutorily address conditions under which the State
33	Board of Education may administratively consolidate public school districts
34	that are currently facing administrative consolidation. Therefore, an
35	emergency is declared to exist, and this act being immediately necessary for
36	the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become

effective on:		
(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
<pre>bill; or</pre>		
(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
