(ii) If the ultrasound image indicates that the unborn child has died, the physician or qualified technician shall inform the pregnant woman of that fact; (C) Display the ultrasound images so that the pregnant woman may view them and document in the pregnant woman's medical record that the ultrasound images were displayed to the pregnant woman; (D) Provide a medical description of the ultrasound images, including the dimensions of the unborn child and the presence of external members and internal organs if present and viewable; and (E) Retain the ultrasound image with the date that the ultrasound occurred in the pregnant woman's medical record. SECTION 2. DO NOT CODIFY. <u>SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any provision of</u> this act or the application of this act to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end, the provisions of this act are declared severable. **APPROVED:** 4/11/23

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
