Arkansas Code § 25-1-1007, as enacted by Acts 2023, No. 24 411, is amended to read as follows: 25 25-1-1007. Exemption from divestment for certain investments. 26 If an investment is subject to divestment under this subchapter but is 27 locked into a maturity date and an early divestment would result in a 28 financial penalty and cause a negative financial impact to the state, then 29 the investment is exempt from divestiture under this subchapter in order to prevent financial harm to the state and ensure that the fiduciary duty for 30 31 the Treasurer of State state is met. 32
