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SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 10 11 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 12 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 13 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 14 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 15 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 16 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 17 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 18 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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20 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 21 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 22 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 23 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 24 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 25 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 26 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 27 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 28

SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 29 30 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of the Department of Education - Division of Elementary and Secondary Education 31 32 are, due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the Department of 33 Education - Division of Elementary and Secondary Education to continue to 34 provide essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies for the Department of Education - Division of 35 36 Elementary and Secondary Education to continue such services; and that a

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1	delay in the effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the		
2	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.		
3	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being		
4	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and		
5	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its		
6	passage and approval.		
7	If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall		
8	become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the		
9	Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the		
10	veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house		
11	overrides the veto.
