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16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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18 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 12, Chapter 15, is amended to add a new
19 subchapter to read as follows:

22 - Knife Regulation

24 12-15-401. Definitions.

25 As used in this subchapter:

26 (1) "Knife" means a cutting instrument that includes a sharpened
27 or pointed blade; and

28 (2) "Political subdivision" means:

29 (A) A county;

30 (B) A city;

31 (C) A town;

32 (D) A municipal corporation;

33 (E) A special district;

34 (F) A board, a commission, or an agency of:

35 (i) A city;

- 1 (ii) A town;
- 2 (iii) A municipal corporation; or
- 3 (iv) A special district; or
- 4 (G) Any other local agency.

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6 12-15-402. Consistency in knife regulation.

7 (a) A political subdivision of this state shall not enact an
8 ordinance, rule, or tax relating to the transportation, possession, carrying,
9 sale, transfer, purchase, gift, devise, licensing, registration, or use of a
10 knife or components used to make a knife except as permitted under this
11 section.

12 (b) A political subdivision of this state shall not enact a rule or
13 ordinance relating to the manufacture of a knife that is more restrictive
14 than a rule or ordinance relating to the manufacture of other commercial
15 goods.

16 (c) A political subdivision's rule or ordinance that relates to
17 knives, whether enacted before or after the effective date of this act, shall
18 be repealed and is void.
