Dear Mr. President:

This is to provide notice that pursuant to Article 6, Section 15 of the Arkansas Constitution, on this date I vetoed Senate Bill 227, a measure from the Eighty-Fifth General Assembly. Also in accordance with Article 6, Section 15, the bill is being returned to this body, the originating house for the bill, and accompanies this letter.

Under Article 5, Section 21, "[n]o bill shall be so altered or amended on its passage through either house, as to change its original purpose." As reflected in its title, the original purpose of this bill was to authorize counties to employ district judges to preside over first appearances in county courts. However, on April 7, the bill's title, sponsor and text were completely changed. As amended and passed, the bill now deals with the authorization of justices of the peace to perform marriages statewide. It is clear that the amendment violates the above constitutional provision. But for this unfortunate problem, I would heartily support the bill. While it pains me greatly to do so, I must veto it.
