Subtitle of House Bill No. 1836

"TO AMEND THE LAWS PERTAINING TO EARLY VOTING."

Amendment No. 2 to House Bill No. 1836.

Amend House Bill No. 1836 as originally introduced:

Page 1, delete lines 24 through 27 and substitute:

"(2)(A) Between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, and 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. on Saturday, beginning fifteen (15) days before an election and ending on the day before election day at the time the county clerk's office regularly closes.

(B)(i) The early voting hours provided for in subdivision (a)(2)(A) shall apply to early voting in primary, general, the corresponding run-off election, and statewide special elections.

(ii) For all other special elections, including but not limited to school board, township, municipal, and county special elections, early voting shall be available during regular office hours beginning fifteen (15) days before an election and ending on the day before election day at the time the county clerk's office regularly closes.

(iii) The early voting hours provided for in subdivision (a)(2)(A) shall apply to all special elections provided for in subdivision (a)(2)(B)(ii) if the special election is held in conjunction with a primary, general, corresponding run-off election, or statewide special election. "

AND

Page 1, line 29, insert:

"SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 7-5-418, concerning early voting, is amended by adding an additional subsection to read as follows:

(i)(1) Within fifteen (15) calendar days after the election, the county clerk shall examine the list of voters to determine if any person voted more than one (1) time.

(2) In the event a person has voted more than one (1) time, the county clerk shall immediately forward the list of names to the county board. "
