Subtitle of Senate Bill No. 360

"AN ACT TO PROVIDE JUVENILE AFTERCARE INFORMATION TO LAW
ENFORCEMENT OFFICIALS."

Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 360.

Amend Senate Bill No. 360 as originally introduced:

Delete everything after the enacting clause and substitute:

"SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 12-12-1001, concerning criminal history reporting definitions, is amended to add an additional subdivision to read as follows:

(14) "Juvenile aftercare and custody information" means information maintained by the Division of Youth Services regarding the status of a juvenile committed or otherwise placed in the custody of the Division of Youth Services from the date of commitment until the juvenile is released from aftercare or custody, whichever is later. Juvenile aftercare and custody information may include the name, address, and phone number of a contact person or entity responsible for the juvenile.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 12-12-1003(a), concerning the collection of criminal history information, is amended to read as follows:

(a) This subchapter governs the ~~collection, maintenance, and dissemination of:~~

(1) Collection, maintenance, and dissemination of criminal history information on identifiable individuals charged or pleading guilty or nolo contendere to, or being found guilty of, criminal offenses under the laws of the State of Arkansas; and

(2) The dissemination of juvenile aftercare and custody information.

SECTION 3. Arkansas Code 12-12-1008(a), concerning the dissemination of criminal justice information, is amended to read as follows:

(a) Pending conviction, and nonconviction information available through the Arkansas Crime Information Center, plus information obtained through the Interstate Identification Index or from another state's record system, and juvenile aftercare and custody information shall be disseminated
