Amendment No. 3 to Senate Bill No. 108.

Amend Senate Bill No. 108 as engrossed, S2/3/09 (version: 02-03-2009 09:05):

Page 2, delete SECTION 2 in its entirety and substitute:

"SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-17-2603, as amended by Act 224 of 2009, is amended to read as follows:

6-17-2603. Eligibility.

To be eligible for a lifetime teaching license, the licensed educator must:

- (1) Hold a current or expired Arkansas teaching license; and
- (2) Meet the following criteria:

(A) Be at least sixty-two (62) years of age; and have

either:

~~(3) Have either:~~

~~(A)(i)~~ Worked in an educational setting while maintaining an Arkansas teaching license; or

~~(B)(ii)~~ Made significant contributions to education, educational research, or the profession of teaching through scholarly endeavors, teaching experience, excellence in teaching, or educational innovation; or

(B) Have retired as a public school teacher who taught public school for not less than twenty-five (25) years."
