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### Subtitle of House Bill No. 1045

REGARDING A PERSON INCARCERATED IN A COUNTY JAIL OR IN THE  
DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION FILING INSTRUMENTS AFFECTING TITLE OR  
INTEREST IN REAL PROPERTY.

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### Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1045

Amend House Bill No. 1045 as originally introduced:

Page 1, line 11 delete "PROPERTY" and substitute "PROPERTY; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY"

AND

Page 1, line 18 delete "PROPERTY" and substitute "PROPERTY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY"

AND

Page 2, line 5 delete "(b)(1)" and substitute "(b)(1)(A)"



AND

Page 2, delete line 6 and substitute:

"(a) of this section is guilty of a Class A misdemeanor.

(B) A person who has a previous conviction under subdivision (b)(1)(A) of this section upon conviction is guilty of a Class D felony for a subsequent violation of subsection (a) of this section."

AND

Page 2, line 17 delete "or"

AND

Page 2, line 21 delete "States." and substitute:

"States;

(G) A person elected to a federal, state, or local position; or

(H) A person employed by the Attorney General."

AND

Page 2, line 34 insert:

"SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the filing of false liens by persons for vengeful reasons has become a large problem in these United States; that currently Arkansas has inadequate statutes to address this

growing problem; and that this act is immediately necessary because citizens as well as persons engaged in law enforcement and the judiciary need immediate protection. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:

(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;

(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill;  
or

(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto."
