TO INCREASE THE ADDITIONAL FEE FOR FIREFIGHTER LICENSE PLATES TO FIVE
DOLLARS (\$5.00) AND HAVE THE FUNDS REMITTED TO THE ARKANSAS FALLEN
FIREFIGHTERS MEMORIAL BOARD.

Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 404

Amend Senate Bill No. 404 as originally introduced:

Page 1, line 11, delete "BOARD;" and substitute "BOARD; TO DECLARE AN
EMERGENCY;"

AND

Delete the subtitle in its entirety and substitute:

"TO INCREASE THE ADDITIONAL FEE FOR
FIREFIGHTER LICENSE PLATES TO FIVE
DOLLARS (\$5.00) AND HAVE THE FUNDS
REMITTED TO THE ARKANSAS FALLEN
FIREFIGHTERS MEMORIAL BOARD; TO DECLARE
AN EMERGENCY."

AND

Add Senators L. Chesterfield, J. Dismang, Elliott, Files, Fletcher, J.
Hutchinson, G. Jeffress, J. Jeffress, J. Key, Luker, Rapert, Salmon, R.
Thompson, D. Wyatt as cosponsors of the bill

AND

Add Representatives Summers, Vines, Hickerson, Hall, Barnett, Dale, Lovell,
Nickels, Patterson, J. Roebuck, Stewart as cosponsors of the bill

AND

Page 3, delete line 21 and substitute:



"the design-use contribution fee under § 27-15-5201 et seq.

SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the Arkansas Fallen Firefighters Memorial Board has made great efforts to have fallen firefighters honored on the grounds of the State Capitol with a monument and memorial area; that additional funding is needed to make the monument and memorial area a reality in the near future; and that this act is necessary because an increase in the fees dedicated for fundraising purposes for the firefighter special license plates will allow construction to begin on the Fallen Firefighters monument and memorial area. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on May 1, 2011."
