Subtitle of House Bill No. 1809

TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE LICENSING OF VOICE STRESS ANALYSIS EXAMINERS.

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1809

Amend House Bill No. 1809 as originally introduced:

Page 2, line 36, delete "(a) The ~~Arkansas~~" and substitute "(a)(1) ~~The Arkansas~~"

AND

Page 3, delete line 1 and substitute the following:
~~"Agencies shall collect~~ Except as provided under subdivision (a)(2) of this section, the applicant for licensure under this subchapter shall"

AND

Page 3, line 5, delete "~~(2)~~(1)" and substitute "~~(2)~~(A)"

AND

Page 3, line 7, delete "~~(3)~~(2)" and substitute "~~(3)~~(B)"

AND

Page 3, line 10, delete "(3)" and substitute "(C)"

AND

Page 3, line 12, delete "(4)" and substitute "(D)"

AND

Page 3, delete line 13 and substitute the following:
"examiner's license, ten dollars (\$10.00).

(2) A certified law enforcement officer who is a full-time employee of a law enforcement agency and who is applying for his or her license for the purpose of full-time employment is not required to pay the fee under subdivisions (a)(1)(A) and (B) of this section."



AND

Page 5, delete line 14 and substitute the following:
"recorded as a part of the interview.

(d)(1) A certified law enforcement officer who is a full-time employee of a law enforcement agency and who is acting in the course of his or her employment for the law enforcement agency may conduct a voice stress analysis from a legally recorded conversation.

(2) If the test is conducted under subdivision (d)(1) of this section:

(A) The recorded conversation may be recorded:

(i) In person; or

(ii) By telephone; and

(B) The examiner shall comply with subsection (c) of this section."

AND

Page 5, delete line 31 and substitute the following:
"obtained concerning the applicant.

(e) This section does not apply to a certified law enforcement officer who is a full-time employee of a law enforcement agency and who is applying for his or her license for the purpose of the full-time employment with the law enforcement agency."
