**Subtitle of Senate Bill No. 999**

TO PROVIDE THAT POSSESSION OF A FIREARM BY A PERSON OR IN A PERSON'S VEHICLE IS NOT A  
CRIMINAL OFFENSE UNLESS THE POSSESSION OF THE FIREARM SPECIFICALLY VIOLATES  
ANOTHER FEDERAL, STATE, OR LOCAL STATUTE.

**Amendment No. 2 to Senate Bill No. 999**

Amend Senate Bill No. 999 as originally introduced:

Delete everything after the enacting clause and substitute:

"SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 5, Chapter 73, Subchapter 1, is amended to add a new section to read as follows:

5-73-112. Possession of a firearm permitted.

Possession or constructive possession of a firearm by a person, including in the person's vehicle, is not a criminal offense unless the possession specifically violates:

- (1) Federal law;
- (2) State law; or
- (3) Local ordinance."
