**Subtitle of Senate Bill No. 182**

TO REGULATE THE ELIGIBILITY OF CERTAIN RETIREES TO PARTICIPATE IN THE STATE AND  
PUBLIC SCHOOL LIFE AND HEALTH INSURANCE PROGRAM.

**Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 182**

Amend Senate Bill No. 182 as originally introduced:

Delete Senator Bledsoe as a cosponsor of the bill

AND

Page 2, delete lines 5 through 12, and substitute the following:

"(B)(i) A retiree shall be continuously enrolled in the program if actively employed in a position that is eligible to participate in the program.

(ii)(a) A retiree who has a break in enrollment in the program may be considered to be continuously enrolled in the program if the retiree:

(1) Applies for participation in the program within thirty-one (31) days of returning to active employment; and

(2) Is employed in a position that is eligible to participate in the program.

(b) If a retiree declines to participate in the program upon returning to active employment under subdivision (a)(5)(B)(ii)(a) of this section, the retiree may participate in the program based on the year of the retiree's most recent enrollment in the program.

(iii) A retiree who declines to participate in the program at the time of retirement is not considered continuously enrolled in the program."
