Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 227

Amend Senate Bill No. 227 as originally introduced:

Delete the title in its entirety and substitute the following:

"AN ACT CONCERNING THE OFFENSE OF CRIMINAL IMPERSONATION; CONCERNING UNLAWFUL
MARKINGS INTENDED TO RESEMBLE A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER OR VEHICLE;
CONCERNING A COURT ORDER FOR IMMEDIATE REMOVAL; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

AND

Delete the subtitle in its entirety and substitute the following:

"AN ACT CONCERNING THE OFFENSE OF CRIMINAL IMPERSONATION; CONCERNING UNLAWFUL
MARKINGS INTENDED TO RESEMBLE A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER OR VEHICLE; AND
CONCERNING A COURT ORDER FOR IMMEDIATE REMOVAL."

AND

Page 1, delete lines 34 through 36

AND

Page 2, delete line 1 and substitute the following:

"(B) Uses a motor vehicle or motorcycle designed, equipped, or
marked with an emblem, logo, marking, decal, insignia, or design so as to
resemble a motor vehicle or motorcycle belonging to a federal, state, or
local law enforcement agency or law enforcement officer."

AND

Page 2, line 28, delete "shall" and substitute "may"
