Amendment No. 2 to House Bill No. 1742

Amend House Bill No. 1742 as engrossed, H3/9/17 (version: 03/09/2017 12:07:11 PM):

Page 2, delete lines 9 through 15, and substitute the following:

"(f)(1)(A) ~~Any~~ A person who suffers actual damage or injury an actual financial loss as a result of an offense or violation as defined in this chapter has a cause of action his or her reliance on the use of a practice declared unlawful by this chapter may bring an action to recover actual damages, if appropriate, and reasonable attorney's fees his or her actual financial loss proximately caused by the offense or violation, as defined in this chapter.

(B) A private class action under this subsection is prohibited unless the claim is being asserted for a violation of Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 89."
