TO AMEND THE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE ACT; AND CONCERNING THE ADOPTION OF A NEW  
RULE BY A STATE AGENCY.

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**Amendment No. 2 to Senate Bill No. 512**

Amend Senate Bill No. 512 as engrossed, S3/22/17 (version: 03/22/2017 02:23:55 PM):

Page 1, line 8, delete "ADMINISTRATIVE" and substitute "ARKANSAS ADMINISTRATIVE"

AND

Page 1, delete line 9, and substitute the following:  
"CONCERNING THE IDENTIFICATION OF ARCHAIC RULES BY A STATE"

AND

Delete the subtitle in its entirety and substitute:  
"TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS ADMINISTRATIVE  
PROCEDURE ACT; AND CONCERNING THE  
IDENTIFICATION OF ARCHAIC RULES BY A  
STATE AGENCY."

AND

Delete everything after the enacting clause and substitute the following:

"SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 25, Chapter 15, Subchapter 2, is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

25-15-220. Review of archaic rules.

(a)(1) As used in this section, "agency" means a board, commission, department, officer, or other authority of the government of the State of Arkansas, whether within, or subject to review by, another agency, except the General Assembly, the courts, and Governor.

(2) The word "agency" shall include without limitation the:

(A) Division of Child Care and Early Childhood Education of the Department of Human Services;

(B) Arkansas Public Service Commission;

(C) Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission;

(D) Worker's Compensation Commission; and



(E) Department of Workforce Services.

(a)(1) On or before October 1, 2018, each agency shall:

(A) Study its rules to identify rules that are archaic or otherwise outdated; and

(B) Provide a list of rules that are archaic or otherwise outdated to the Legislative Council.

(2) An agency may elect to promulgate the repeal of an archaic or otherwise outdated rule rather than identifying the rule on the list of rules under subdivision (a)(1)(B) of this section.

(b) In advance of the commencement of the Ninety-second General Assembly in January of 2019, the Legislative Council shall:

(1) Review the lists of archaic or otherwise outdated rules provided under subsection (a) of this section; and

(2) Provide to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives a list of outdated or archaic agency rules that are no longer necessary.

(c) This section shall expire on February 1, 2019."
