Subtitle of House Bill No. 1019

TO REQUIRE VIDEO CAMERAS IN CERTAIN CLASSROOMS UPON REQUEST.

**Amendment No. 1 to House Bill 1019**

Amend House Bill No. 1019 as originally introduced:

Page 1, delete line 9, and substitute the following:

"UPON REQUEST; TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

AND

Delete the subtitle in its entirety and substitute the following:

"TO REQUIRE VIDEO CAMERAS IN CERTAIN CLASSROOMS UPON REQUEST; AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY."

AND

Page 1, delete lines 29 through 36

AND

Page 2, delete lines 1 through 36

AND

Page 3, delete line 1

AND

Page 3, line 2, delete "(3)" and substitute "(2)"

AND

Page 3, delete lines 3 and 4, and substitute the following:

"school that is comprised of students with disabilities, as defined in the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, 20 U.S.C. § 1400 et seq., who spend less than forty percent (40%) of the school day in a regular classroom environment; and"



AND

Page 3, line 5, delete "(4)" and substitute "(3)"

AND

Page 5, line 2, delete "three (3) months" and substitute "thirty (30) days"

AND

Page 5, line 27, delete "and related"

AND

Page 5, line 28, delete "services"

AND

Page 5, line 29, delete "(i)" and substitute "(i)(1)"

AND

Page 5, delete line 31, and substitute the following:

"shall not be released or viewed.

(2) A video recording of a student under this section is an education record under the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act, 20 U.S.C. § 1232(g), as it existed on January 1, 2019."

AND

Page 7, delete line 31, and substitute the following:

"of this section.

(r) The Division of Youth Services of the Department of Human Services is exempt from this section.

SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the safety of students is of the utmost importance; that parents should be able to monitor their children while their children are at school and hold accountable those responsible for their children while their children are at school; and that this act is immediately necessary to protect students who are currently in school from any inappropriate or unwanted action from those who are responsible for the students at school. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:

(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;

(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill; or

(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto."
