**Subtitle of Senate Bill No. 169**

CONCERNING THE TERM OF A DISTRICT JUDGE.

---

**Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill 169**

Amend Senate Bill No. 169 as originally introduced:

Immediately following SECTION 1 of the bill, add an additional section to read as follows:

"SECTION 2. DO NOT CODIFY. (a) The enabling legislation for Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 80, did not contain language concerning the date of the first election for district judges under Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 80, though the first election for district judges after passage of Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 80, occurred at the 2004 general election.

(b) To avoid confusion in some areas of the state concerning the cycle for elections of district judges, the next election for a district judge shall be held at the 2020 general election."
