CONCERNING THREATS OR STATEMENTS THAT A PERSON INTENDS TO USE A CONTROLLED
SUBSTANCE WHILE PREGNANT OR INTRODUCE A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE INTO THE BODY OF
A PREGNANT WOMAN.

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill 1024

Amend House Bill No. 1024 as originally introduced:

Page 1, delete line 11, and substitute the following:

"A PREGNANT WOMAN; CONCERNING THE INTRODUCTION OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE INTO
THE BODY OF A PREGNANT WOMAN; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

AND

Delete the subtitle in its entirety and substitute the following:

"CONCERNING THE THREAT OF OR ACTUAL INTRODUCTION OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE
INTO THE BODY OF A PREGNANT WOMAN."

AND

Page 1, delete line 24, and substitute the following:

"SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-1-102(13)(B)(i)(a), concerning the
definition of "person" and its application in the Arkansas Criminal Code, is
amended to read as follows:

(B)(i)(a) As used in §§ 5-10-101 – 5-10-105 and 5-13-210,
"person" also includes an unborn child in utero at any stage of development.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 5, Chapter 13, Subchapter 2, is
amended"

AND

Page 1, delete line 32, and substitute the following:

"to introduce a Schedule I or Schedule II controlled substance as defined by



the Uniform Controlled"

AND

Page 1, delete line 36, and substitute the following:

"a Schedule I or Schedule II controlled substance as defined by the Uniform Controlled Substances Act, §"

AND

Page 2, delete line 9, and substitute the following:

"the person is no longer able to introduce a Schedule I or Schedule II controlled substance as defined"

AND

Page 2, delete line 13, and substitute the following:

"was ordered for the person receiving the Schedule I or Schedule II controlled substance by a"
