Amendment No. 1 to House Bill 1280

Amend House Bill No. 1280 as originally introduced:

Page 1, line 35 delete "<u>A municipality's consideration</u>" and substitute "<u>Consideration</u>"

AND

Page 2, delete lines 1 through 2 and substitute the following: "Development Act of 2017, § 14-176-101 et seq. if: (a) A public discussion would give an advantage to competitors or bidders; or

(b) <u>The discussion concerns records</u> maintained by an economic development service provider for a municipality or county related to an economic development project; or

(c) <u>The discussion concerns records</u> <u>maintained by the municipality or county related to an economic development</u> <u>project's:</u>

> (1) Planning; (2) Site location; (3) Expansion; (4) Operations; or (5) Product development and marketing."

Page 2, line 3, delete "(B)" and substitute "(B)(i)"

AND

Page 2, line 4, delete "session" and substitute the following: "session.

(ii) If an executive session is called under subdivision (c)(l)(A)(ii), notice of the intent to call an executive session to discuss an economic development project and the specific purpose of the executive session shall be published with the notice of the open public meeting."

AND

Page 2, line 18, delete "(B)" and substitute "(B)(i)"

AND

Page 2, line 20, delete "<u>invite</u>" and substitute "<u>invite the person holding</u> the top administrative position in the public agency, department, or office <u>involved</u>, and"

AND

Page 2, delete line 21 and substitute the following: "session.

(ii) At the conclusion of an executive session called under subdivision (c)(l)(A)(ii) of this section, the discussion during the executive session shall be orally summarized, and the oral summary shall be reflected in the minutes of the meeting.

(iii) The oral summary required under subdivision (c)(2)(B)(ii) may exclude the information under subdivision (c)(1)(A)(ii)(c)."
